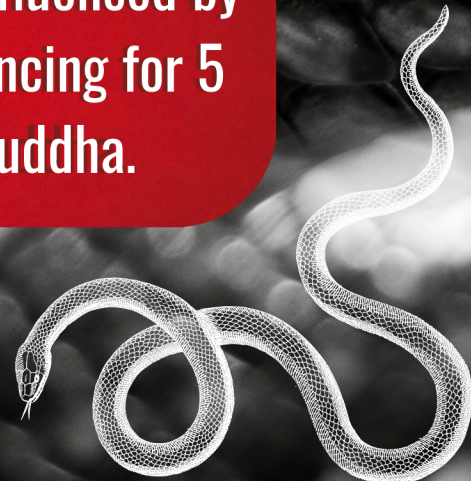


Madi Moon

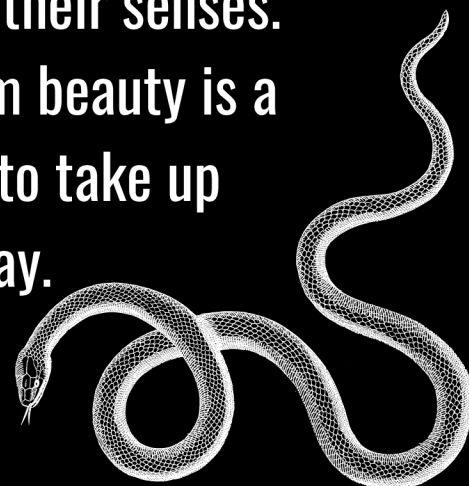
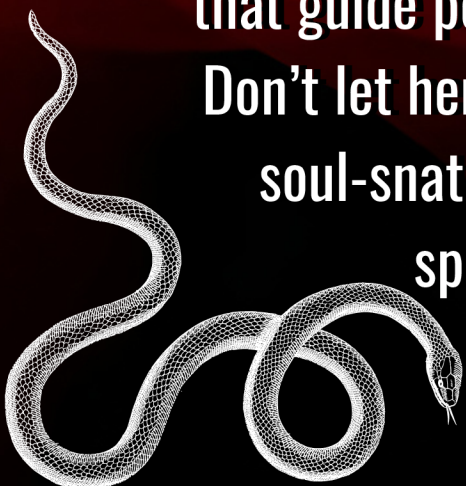

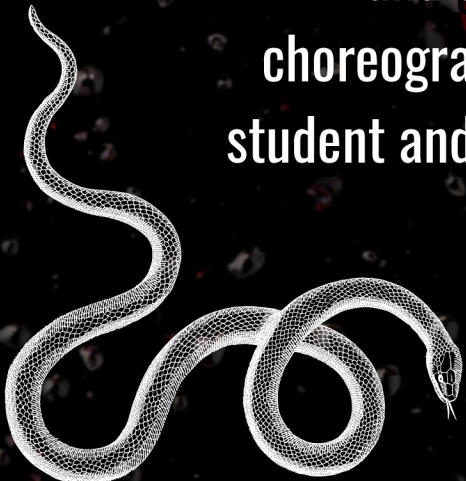
